Are you being denied employment because of something in your past?

The Federal Bonding Program can help assure employers that you'd be a safe bet for a position.

Gain the trust of employers – get a fidelity bond

If your past is preventing you from landing a job, talk to a bonding representative at your local One-Stop Career Center today. A bonding representative can provide a potential employer a fidelity bond, which is a special type of insurance that protects employers from employee dishonesty resulting in loss of money or property. Employers are more willing to hire a job applicant seen as “high-risk” if the applicant is backed with a fidelity bond.

Do I qualify?

If something in your past is leading employers to question your integrity and deny you a job, you may qualify.

For example, the Federal Bonding Program can help:

- people with poor personal credit
- people dishonorably discharged from the military
- people without a consistent work history
- justice-involved individuals
- recovering substance abusers
